Manila International Airport or Cebu -
Mactan International Airport.

We can organise a transportation with a

From Dumaguete head south on the
National Highway. Make a left turn to
Tambobo Bay (or when you see the
Cove Paradise sign). Stay on this
country road, after 5 km turn right. In 2
km turn left to the Cove Paradise
Beach & Dive Resort.

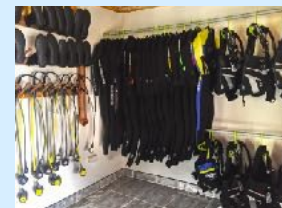

INFORMATION

HOW LONG I CAN STAY?

You will be issued with a 30 day tourist visa on arrival in the Philippines. This can be extended almost indefinitely in 2 months batches at any local Immigration office around the country. The nearest immigration office from our Resort is in Dumaguete and the extension of the visa takes ca. 30 min and you can pick it up after 2 days.

WHAT CLOTHES SHOULD I PACK?

In the Philippines it is all year around warm and the temperature range from 27C to 33C. Shorts and T-shirts are going to work for day and night. A rain jacket can be useful all year around.

THINGS TO DO



There is a lot to explore in Negros Oriental. For example, Lake Balanan, next to Siaton, is a freshwater lake and it's good for a half day excursion with a beautiful lake and a small waterfall in the end.

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FILIPINOS



CULTURAL DIFFERENCES

Filipinos are warm & welcoming & generally very informal.

They may often seem quite liberal in nature but they do maintain a cultural conservatism.

Filipinos are generally deferential to older senior members of society & this can include tourists. It can therefore be inappropriate to lose your temper or raise your voice when dealing with locals. The Asian concept of 'saving face' also applies in the Philippines so its best to try & resold disputes in mutually respectful manner, especially if they have a public dimension.
